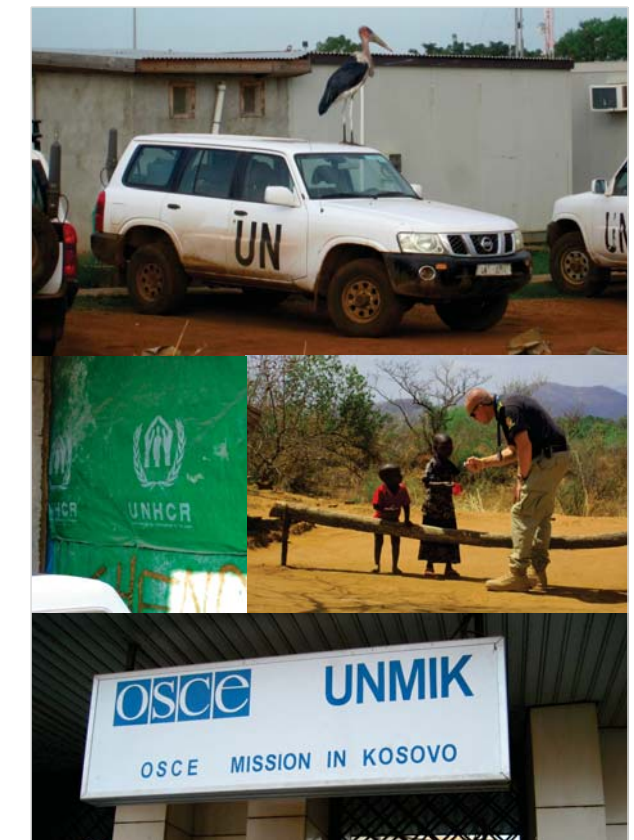

**Admission Requirements**

- Successful completion of a university/college (BA, BSc and MA, MSc or equivalent) degree comprising of at least 240 credit points (CPs) in the subjects of law, psychology, sociology or other relevant fields;
- at least one year of relevant practical experience after graduation;
- an excellent knowledge of the English language.

Any lacking CPs can be gained through additional attainments. This may also be through recognition of attainments achieved at other universities, special training programs or a certain amount of work experience in years.
