**What will I do?** You will work in international teams with students from Italy, Slovenia and Portugal on a case of confiscation and asset recovery law and argue for your side before the judges. There will be an introductory session to the topic. Knowledge of confiscation and asset recovery law is **not** required.

**Do I need to speak Italian?** No, everything is done in English.

**How much does it cost?** Travelling and living costs are fully covered by the Jean-Monnet-Program of the EU, as is food during group activities.
